

RESOLUTION REGARDING PERSONAL RAPID TRANSIT (PRT)
IN THE MIDTOWN GREENWAY
Passed by the Midtown Greenway Coalition board on June 8, 2004

WHEREAS The Midtown Greenway Coalition has studied and discussed PRT during its March, April, and May 2004 Streetcar Committee meetings, and

WHEREAS the Midtown Greenway Coalition believes that all multi-modal transit should be effectively integrated and should be supported by a dedicated source of transit funding;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that The Midtown Greenway Coalition reaffirms its belief that a streetcar system is currently the most appropriate technology for the corridor, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that should PRT be shown to be viable in the future in an urban setting similar to that of the Greenway neighborhoods, the Midtown Greenway may reconsider its position, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Coalition supports funding for a streetcar in the Midtown Greenway and funding for mass transit in general.
